Limited entry, places on a ‘first come first served’ basis. Payment for phone/e-mail entries must be received within 4 days. No refund for cancellations received after the Closing Date.

- GNAS Rules of Shooting for a non-Record Status FITA25 Round will apply
- Compound & Recurve will shoot on *triple-spot* faces.
- Longbow & Barebow will shoot on *single-spot* faces.
- GNAS Dress Code is optional, but preferred.

Juniors under 16 yrs of age must be accompanied by their parent/guardian whilst on the premises. A named adult must supervise juniors 16 to 18 yrs. Neither the Organisers nor the Judges can act as supervisors of juniors.

FOOTWEAR: Smooth soled indoor footwear **must** be worn. Outdoor footwear on the bowling area is strictly forbidden by the B.C.A.

In accordance with GNAS Child & Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy anyone wishing to use any photographic, or image-capturing equipment, must notify the Organiser before the event and sign the registration form available on the day.

Trophies and other Awards List

Recurve/Compound/Longbow: Gentlemen/Ladies/Junior Gentlemen/Junior Ladies:

- 1st Scores Trophies and Medals

The number of awarded scores in each of the above categories will be subject to ‘not more than half the number of entries in each category’ up to a maximum of 3, but the first scores will be awarded regardless of entry numbers.

Visually Impaired Archers

- 1st Score Trophy and Medal

Recurve Barebow – awards according to entries

Novices and Veterans Recurve/Compound/Longbow:

- 1st Scores Medal

Club Team:

Comprising of three archers of any style, but not more than one Compound.

Novice: An archer who has not competed in an Open Tournament.

Veteran: An archer 60 years of age or older.

Juniors: May enter the Senior category, but in so doing will not qualify for the Junior awards.

Trophies: All trophies are returnable Challenge Trophies to be held for one year only. Current holders are requested to return them, in a clean condition, to the Tournament Secretary on the day of the shoot or by Guaranteed Post during the week beforehand.
